> *ARRIVAL DAY*

The official arrival day for YOTA Summer Camp 2026 is Saturday, 25 July 2026.

The camp will take place in Wagrain, Austria, located in the beautiful Austrian Alps, approximately 70 km south of Salzburg.

As participants are travelling from many different countries across Europe, Africa, and Asia, we recommend arriving via one of the major international airports listed below.

- **Vienna International Airport (VIE)**

Vienna Airport is Austria's largest international airport and offers direct connections to many destinations worldwide. It is the recommended arrival airport for participants travelling from Eastern Europe, the Balkans, the Middle East, Africa, and Asia.

- **Munich Airport (MUC)**

Munich Airport is one of Europe's largest aviation hubs and provides excellent international connections. It is especially convenient for participants arriving from Western and Northern Europe as well as intercontinental destinations.



TRAVELLING BY TRAIN FROM VIENNA AIRPORT

Austria has an excellent railway network operated by ÖBB (Austrian Federal Railways). After arriving at Vienna International Airport (VIE), proceed directly to the railway station located underneath the airport terminal:

Station: Wien Flughafen (Vienna Airport Railway Station)

Recommended Route

Wien Flughafen (Vienna Airport Railway Station) → Salzburg Hauptbahnhof (Salzburg Main Station) → St. Johann im Pongau Bahnhof (St. Johann im Pongau Railway Station)

Please note carefully:

Your destination railway station is "St. Johann im Pongau Bahnhof (St. Johann im Pongau Railway Station)". **Do not leave or take the train at stations named "St. Johann"** in other regions, as there are several stations with similar names in Austria and Germany. The total travel time is approximately 3-4 hours depending on the selected connection.

TRAVELLING BY TRAIN FROM MUNICH AIRPORT

Participants arriving at Munich Airport (MUC) should first travel to Munich Central Station.

Recommended Route

München Flughafen Terminal (Munich Airport Terminal Station) → München Hauptbahnhof (Munich Central Station) → Salzburg Hauptbahnhof (Salzburg Main Station) → St. Johann im Pongau Bahnhof (St. Johann im Pongau Railway Station)

Again, please make sure your **final train destination is "St. Johann im Pongau Bahnhof (St. Johann im Pongau Railway Station)"**. The total journey time is usually between 2.5 and 3 hours.

FINAL TRANSFER FROM ST. JOHANN IM PONGAU

The nearest railway station to the camp venue is "St. Johann im Pongau Bahnhof (St. Johann im Pongau Railway Station)".

The YOTA organizing team will provide individual shuttle transportation by car from this station directly to the Jugendhotel Oberwimm in Wagrain. The transfer takes approximately 15 minutes (11km).

To ensure a smooth pickup, participants are requested to provide their arrival time and train details in advance.

Important Information for Drivers

Austrian Motorway Vignette

Most Austrian motorways require a valid motorway toll sticker ("Vignette").

If you use Austrian motorways (Autobahnen / motorways), a valid vignette is mandatory.

You can purchase:

- A digital vignette online before travelling
- A physical vignette at border crossings, petrol stations, and motorway service areas

Parking

Free parking will be available at or near the camp venue for participants and team leaders arriving by car.

Recommended Routes

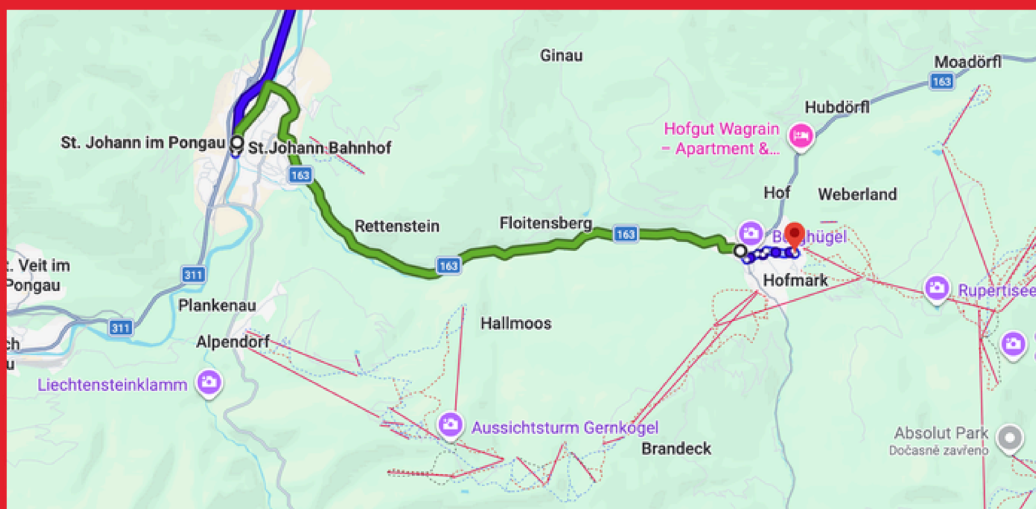
From Vienna:

- A1 Westautobahn (Western Motorway) towards Salzburg
- Exit towards Bischofshofen / St. Johann im Pongau
- Continue via B311 and local roads to Wagrain

From Munich:

- A8 motorway towards Salzburg
- Continue towards Bischofshofen / St. Johann im Pongau
- Follow signs to Wagrain

Please allow additional travel time during the summer holiday season, especially on Saturdays, as traffic can be heavy in the Alpine regions.



> *DEPARTURE DAY*

The official departure day is Saturday, 1 August 2026.

To ensure a smooth departure, the YOTA organizing team will provide shuttle transportation from the camp venue in Wagrain to St. Johann im Pongau Bahnhof (St. Johann im Pongau Railway Station).

From there, participants can continue their journey by train to Salzburg, Vienna Airport, Munich Airport, or other destinations.

Please note that no large shuttle bus to Salzburg will be provided. The Austrian railway network offers fast and frequent connections, and travelling by train from St. Johann im Pongau is generally quicker and more efficient than travelling by bus to Salzburg first.

Participants are therefore encouraged to plan their onward journey by train from St. Johann im Pongau Bahnhof.

Individual Travel Arrangements

If you plan to:

- Arrive before the official arrival day.
- Depart after the official departure day.
- Have special travel requirements.
- Need assistance with flight or train connections.
